Group kit – This is supplied by Deptford Green School

- o 3-person tent
- First aid kit
- o 50L rucksack
- Sleeping bag
- Camping stove
- Compass and mapping equipment

Personal kit – This needs to be purchased

- 1 pair of walking boots these must be broken in, recommend buy 2 months before expedition.
- Minimum of 2 pairs of walking socks
- Waterproof coat
- o At least 2 comfortable walking outfits (tops, walking trousers, underwear). **No jeans.**
- o Pyjamas
- o Flip flops to wear around the campsite
- Wash kit (soap, toothpaste, towel)
- 2L refillable water bottle (no other drinks permitted; these will be confiscated)
- Torch
- Cutlery
- Food (see list on school website)
- o Tin opener
- Tea towel
- Insect repellent
- o Small amount of money, no more than £15

Additional considerations

You will be carrying all this equipment for the duration of your hike so make sure your rucksack isn't too heavy. Wear your rucksack around your house for 20 minutes to check that it is not too heavy. Those who overpack always have blisters and don't enjoy the expedition!

If the weather is hot, sun cream and hat are required.

Some items on the **personal kit list can be purchased as a group** e.g., groups will not need more than 2 torches between them.

The campsite will have toilet and shower facilities.
