How to revise in Year 11

Key ways to revise:

To begin...

- Build up from the basics.
- Do a little bit, often.
- Find different strategies for re-learning.
- Complete independent tasks set by your teacher.
- Don't time your work too soon, it isn't a race!

To build and consolidate your knowledge...

- Practice exam papers
- Time yourself and focus on understanding where it went right and where it went wrong.
- Mark your answers carefully and re-do anything you got wrong.
- Revise lots of different topics in rotation.
- Resist the temptation just to study the topics you like.

To master your subject...

- Practise more exam papers.
- Go through all the papers. Note down unfamiliar questions and how to solve similar questions.
- Understand the mark scheme.
- Gradually reduce the reliance on the formula sheet.
