Evidence shows that students who attend school more regularly and who are punctual are more successful and secure better outcomes. Students who have 96-100% attendance miss less learning time and are, therefore, more successful at school and more likely to achieve their full potential. If your child is going to be absent from school, please notify a member of your child's pastoral team and report the absence daily through Studybugs so that we know they are at home safe, and we do not need to waste valuable time following up unknown absences.

Why do we organise a Graduation event?

The Y7 Graduation Event is to celebrate your child's successful transition from primary school into secondary school and from Year 7 into Year 8! It is to celebrate how well students have adhered to and demonstrated our school ethos and GREAT values!



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How do your child graduate?

From last week and until mid-May, your child will be asked to complete a series of tasks to prove that they have understood and can demonstrate our school values. According to how well they complete those tasks, they will access and graduate on different levels of achievement: from bronze, silver, gold to platinum. The graduation is NOT linked to the amount of LORIC points they get throughout the year. There will also be a few additional special surprise certificates awarded during that evening.

What are those tasks?

Each grid allows your child to score 12 points. The Head of Year has created 4 grid tasks (total of 48 points), one poster task (8 points) and cards (4 points). See an example of our Growth grid attached.

Growth – grid – 12 points – completed!

Great Effort – grid – 12 points – completed!

Equality & Togetherness – poster – 8 points – completed!

Respect – grid – 12 points – summer 1 – due Friday 3rd May

Great Organisation – grid – 12 points – summer 1

Kindness & Gratitude – thank you cards – 4 points – summer 1

How do they graduate Platinum/Gold/Bronze/Silver?

The total points equals 60 points. If a child gets below 20, they will not be able to graduate. The more tasks they complete the higher the award category they achieve. Thanks for discussing the Graduation with your child and **encouraging them to complete all the tasks to the best of their ability** so they make themselves proud on Thursday 13th June!

Following parents' evening, another **email will be sent so you can book your ticket to the event.**
