GCSE

All year 11 students have received their exam entry statement which they should have brought home and shown to you. Intervention

After school interventions are continuing and are more important than ever in the last few weeks of school. You should have received a letter informing you of the interventions your child is expected to attend. It is imperative that they attend the subjects they have been identified for as this is based on PPE results. Interventions run from 3.15 pm -4.15pm.


Additional intervention in English and Maths are also taking place during tutor sessions on Monday, Wednesday, and Thursday mornings.

Rules

- A minimum of 13/20 criteria is required for you to purchase a prom ticket.
- Students who meet 15 or more criteria will earn money off of the price of the prom
 ticket
- The tasks in bold are compulsory.

Students have been receiving updates on how they are working towards their prom ticket and most year 11 students are on track to attend prom. If your child is on track you will now be able to view and pay for the prom ticket on parent pay which is £32pp. If your child is not on track, they have the next two weeks to work towards completing their passport to prom then their prom ticket will be released on parent pay.

Most home learning is now revision based and will be set on classcharts. If your child is completing independent revision that is great however they should always ensure the revision tasks set by their teachers is completed as it will be exam focused and with teacher instruction and insight.

Our Learning Behaviours and Values

At Deptford Green school we want our young people to not only be successful in their time with us but also in their lives outside of school. We have therefore developed a set of learning behaviours and values that we hope to see in all our young people as we know this will best place them to be successful. Our staff are trained to catch and reward students who get it right and use our posters below to do so. Please familiarise yourself with them and encourage your children to demonstrate the specific behaviours below. Furthermore, make sure you have access to your child's Class Charts account so you can see when staff are rewarding your child points so that you can celebrate with them.

Please be aware that reflections this year now last for up to 60 minutes after school. These are rarely given. Your child will only be expected to stay after school for 1 hour to reflect if they have been removed from a lesson, accrued a high number of behaviour points during the day or if they failed to attend the 30-minute reflection the previous day without communicating this with a member of their pastoral team.
