Dear parents and carers,

Thank you for all the support you have given our Year 11 students in the build up to their exams. We are pleased to see the students attending the Easter revision sessions in great numbers and working hard in their independent learning at home.

GCSE Exams: The final GCSE exam period has already begun, with students doing themselves proud in their Languages speaking exams and their practical exams in Art, Textiles, Photography and Drama.

Next week, the formal written exams will begin. Please find the full timetable of exams attached. The final contingency day is scheduled for Wednesday 25th June, so parents are reminded that students need to be available for exams until that date and should not be taken on holiday until afterwards in case an exam is re-scheduled nationally due to unforeseen circumstances.

If a student is running late on the day of an exam, please contact the school and Ms. Samms urgently so that we can make arrangements. Please also be aware that if students do not attend an exam due to illness, they will not have an opportunity to take the exam at another time.

Only in extreme cases students may receive allowances from the JCQ exam body. If your child is unwell on the day of an exam and you are concerned, please contact the pastoral team urgently.

We will be in touch later in the summer term with details of the plans for GCSE results day, which is on Thursday 21st August. Exam Masterclasses: Beginning next week we will be scheduling a series of exam masterclasses to take place to support students in their learning and revision. In most cases, a masterclass will be offered to all students:

The afternoon of the previous working day before an exam (from 3pm onwards).

The morning of the day of any exam from 8am onwards.



This is an excellent opportunity for students to cover key content and exam skills in the immediate lead up to their assessment with the help of their expert teachers.

We strongly encourage you to support our students in attending these sessions. The schedule for the masterclasses up to May half term is attached and will be shared with students physically.

Uniform and Equipment expectations: During the exam period, all students are required to wear full Deptford Green School uniform including school shoes. All students also require adequate equipment to complete their exams which should include x5 black pens, x2 pencils, ruler, rubber, maths set, scientific calculator and a clear pencil case.


